It's a natural wonder for any ecotourist, and when you choose the Ultimate Haida Gwaii Adventure package, you will spend three nights at Ocean House at Stads K'uns GawaGa, our fly-in access floating wilderness lodge, engulfed by nature and luxurious activities. Once you are fully relaxed, you will travel to our land-based centrally located cultural lodge, Haida House at Tllaal, and experience Haida culture, art, and storytelling.

These very distinctive regions will captivate you and you will leave our land entranced by the beauty and culture of Haida Gwaii.





THE ULTIMATE HAIDA GWAII ADVENTURE

YOUR 7-NIGHT TWO-LODGE ADVENTURE

Immerse yourself in this ultimate Haida Gwaii experience. Imagine 3 nights engulfed by nature at the floating wilderness lodge Ocean House [remote west coast], followed by 4 nights mesmerized by culture at the land-based Haida House at Tllaal [a central east coast location near Tlell]. These very distinctive regions will captivate you through your discovery of the supernatural beauty of old-growth forests, dramatic shorelines thriving with wildlife, ancient village site of SGang Gwaay, and traditions of the Haida people.

DAY 1: SUNDAY

OCEAN HOUSE ARRIVAL

Today, you will fly with North Cariboo Air from Vancouver South Terminal leaving at 7am [check-in time is at 5:45am] to the Sandspit Airport on Haida Gwaii. From here, a breathtaking helicopter ride will take you to Peel Inlet and the Ocean House.

Upon arrival, you will be greeted by the Ocean House team and check-in to your room. Enjoy a delicious breakfast buffet before we discuss the activities that lie ahead. Depending on your interests, our team will discuss the activities that you would like to participate in over the next 3 days.

Today, you may choose from the following activities:

- Discover the beauty of Peel Inlet [guided walk]
- Forest-bath and rejuvenate at Security Inlet or Kaisun Village
- Kayaking / stand-up paddle boarding

- Education opportunities with our Artist in Residence

Lunch, snacks, non-alcoholic beverages including tea and coffee will be provided for you to take on your guided excursion.

Upon returning from your activity, relax and experience the luxurious amenities of the Ocean House. The evening is there to enjoy your gourmet meal in a casual setting. Our Haida Chef works with local ingredients, combining tradition with modern techniques. House wine is included with dinner.

After dinner, choose from a variety of activities; learn more about the area from your cultural interpreters, watch a documentary in our media room, or rejuvenate in the lodge's spa area.

DAYS 2-3: MONDAY - TUESDAY

EXPLORING THE WEST COAST OF HAIDA GWAII

Over the next two days you will engage in captivating guided excursions that showcase the magic of the landscapes and the fascinating history and culture of the Haida who have inhabited the islands since time immemorial.

Each morning starts with a delicious breakfast and a discussion with your guides to discuss the day ahead.

Included activities you can choose from are:

- Discover the many flora and fauna at Peel Inlet [guided walk]
- Forest-bath and rejuvenate at Security Inlet or Kaisun Village
- Explore the ancient village site of Ts'aahl
- Kayaking / stand-up paddle boarding
- Learning from our Artist in Residence

You may also book additional a-la-carte activities to visit nearby sites (additional fees apply):

- Explore the ancient village of K'uuna Llnagaay
- Tour Haida Gwaii by air via helicopter or float plane

Lunch, snacks, non-alcoholic beverages including tea and coffee



will be provided for you to take on your excursion.

The lodge is the perfect place to unwind and soak up the tranquil landscape of Peel Inlet. Relax in our sauna and steam room or book a massage or treatment in our spa [additional costs may apply]. You may also wish to paddle one of the kayaks or stand-up boards to explore the quiet inlet on your own.

Throughout the day and in the evenings, enjoy the storytelling and the creation of art from the cultural interpreters or artists in residence. Our Haida guides are the connection to their culture and history, and we encourage you to get up close and learn as much as you desire.

Appetizers are provided in the lounge late afternoons which is a great time to connect with your fellow travelers to share the experiences with one other. Dinners are served in the dining room and our Haida Chef will serve the freshest and local ingredients, and combines tradition with modern cooking techniques. House wine is included with dinner.

DAY 4: WEDNESDAY DEPART FOR HAIDA HOUSE

Transfer from the Ocean House to Graham Island by helicopter. You will be transferred to Sandspit and shuttled by van across the inlet on a 20 minute ferry ride to Skidegate where you will be welcomed by a Haida House representative and transferred to Haida House. After check in you will enjoy a short beach and river walk along with an orientation reception before dinner.

DAYS 5-7: THURSDAY - SATURDAY

EXPLORING THE NORTH AND SOUTH ISLAND

Over the next three days you'll take part in guided activities in the north of Graham Island, such as Old Massett, Tow Hill, Agate Beach and Port Clements, and in the south end, Skidegate, Queen Charlotte. Highlights include the excursion to S^Gang Gwaay, interpretive forest walks and a Haida dinner in the home of a Haida Chef. Each activity is carefully tailored to give you time to absorb the fascinating Haida culture and allow yourself to recalibrate in some of the most beautiful Island settings. Each day begins after a delicious breakfast with most activities ranging between 6 to 10 hours in length. Lunches and dinners are included.

DAY 8: SUNDAY DEPART HAIDA HOUSE

After a delicious breakfast it is time to say farewell. The Haida House will transfer you back to Sandspit to meet your chartered flight back to Vancouver. From Sandspit, enjoy your 70 minute flight to the Vancouver Airport South Terminal. Your plane will arrive in Vancouver at 1 pm [weather dependent].

Please Note the Following

Package itineraries are dependent on weather, local wildlife, and may vary based on your interests. Adventure plans cannot be confirmed in advance, and all activities are subject to change. Ocean House reserves the right to adjust the itinerary based on these variables.

Once arrived, you can plan your tentative adventure itinerary with your Ocean House guide. Creating memorable experiences is our main goal and your guides will review the day's itinerary with you before departure each morning. Please feel free to let your booking agent know if there are specific activities you'd like to focus on during your stay with us.

The Ocean House is anchored in a remote location with no direct access to roads or well-marked trails. Guests can leave the lodge by foot but due to its remoteness, our guides will help you at the beginning of your stay to get acquainted with the area.
